

DIRECTIONS

Cleaning Greasy Metal (around fryer doors and vents): Use a hot, white towel that is thoroughly wet. Colored towels may bleed causing unwanted messes. Sprinkle a fine mist into towel. Squeeze towel together for a few seconds to dissolve powder. Apply in horizontal and vertical directions. A rinsing towel and paper towel to dry with is recommended.

Cleaning Mops: Add 1 full scoop of MC-Detergent to mop bucket, Fill mop bucket with hot water, only. Plunge mop into bucket 5 times to help dissolve powder and loosen fabric soils. Allow 5 to 10 minutes contact time before rinsing and drying mop. Only clean 1 mop at time.

Cleaning Entryway Concrete: Pre-wet concrete with water. Sprinkle powdered detergent over area needing to be cleaned. Deck brush powder into wet concrete. Rinse with hot or cold water.

Ceiling Tiles: For ceiling tiles above fryer hoods and griddles add 2 to 4 ounces of MC-Detergent in 2 gallons of water. Place a white towel into bucket and mix water and powder together. Ring towel until damp. Apply towel to surface. **Caution: When cleaning overhead surfaces always wear safety glasses.**

Fryer Gloves: Add 4 oz of MC-Detergent to 4 gallons of warm to hot water. Agitate to dissolve powder and soak for 15-20 minutes. Longer times permitted depending on soil level.

Inside Fryers (Boil-out Cleaning): Use 8 ounces (1 scoop) per fryer vat. Add to vat before filling with hot water. Thoroughly rinse before neutralizing with vinegar.

Cleaning Stains (from brewing equipment and canisters): Add 2 to 4 ounces to two gallons of hot water. Agitate solution with cloth or brush. Allow several minutes of contact time to dissolve stains. Rinse thoroughly before sanitizing.

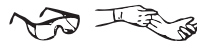
If swallowed: Rinse out mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Call a poison control center or doctor if you feel unwell.
